Members of Wealth Builders BNI held a blood drive on Saturday December 9th in honor of Storm Rushford. Storm is the son of BNI members, Matt and Julieta Rushford.

Storm is a sophomore at CVU high school in Hinesburg, Vermont, where as a freshman he was a high honors student and a standout athlete in both volleyball and baseball, playing on both varsity teams. In July 2017, Storm was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. #StormStrong has become the rallying cry of his teammates, coaches, community, and family as he battles cancer.

Donated blood helps many patients in a wide variety of medical crises, including childhood cancer, where there is often a regular need for transfusions.



Personal friendships, taking one for the teammate, giving for a classmate, a loving family & community were truly exhibited in the preparation of this event and on the day of. To see Storm's friends donate blood for the first time was incredible to witness. The students helped each other get through it and were all eventually smiling.

The turnout was over the top! Many donors were turned away that wanted to donate because simply we were booked from 9 to 3! Our goal was 20 pints and we more than doubled that! 41 pints collected, 12 first time blood donors! Here is a cool fact... One pint of blood can save the lives of 3 people. Those donated amounts will help over 120 people! This does not include others that donated plasma at the center in the morning of the drive!

Great turn out from the Wealth Builders BNI team! Over 50% of the chapter either donated or participated as hosts during the event.
