Monthly Networking Tip: Are we Gossiping in BNI?



This word has a lot of negative connotation in our culture, and for good reason. Seeing that we are all a part of Relationship Networking groups, it was just a matter of time before someone brought this up as a networking tip.

When inquiring with Websters Dictionary, we are told that gossip is simply "casual or unconstrained conversation or reports about other people." However, when one looks up Urban Dictionary's definition, it gets a bit more direct...

"Talking bad about a person and their life."

This second definition is where we all need to address how we are talking about other individuals in our networking efforts.

Over the years of teaching Vermont professionals how to make money through

networking, I've come to my own definition of gossip:

Talking negatively about a person with no intention of addressing the problem or finding a solution.

See, one of the best things about BNI is the friendships. And one of the worst things about BNI is the friendships. And when our personalities, emotions, and personal preferences start to get mixed up with other individuals, we start to wear our emotions on our sleeves and act in unprofessional and unproductive ways.

Now don't get me wrong; I've been guilty of talking about people behind their back. However, I've learned from experience that this results in any of 3 things:

- 1. It hurts my reputation with the person I'm talking with
- 2. It hurts my reputation with the person I'm talking about
- 3. It solidifies an unhealthy practice of complaining without finding a solution

And here's where we get to the meat of today's networking tip. **What does one do when we have a problem with someone else in BNI?** The good news is that there is another way.

First - Suppress the urge to discuss it with anyone in your BNI chapter other than your Membership Committee. Issues with a Referral Partner are always confidentially handled with your MC. And when you don't feel comfortable going to your Membership Committee, reach out to you 0 (0%) r Consultant, or BNI Vermont's Member Services Director, Ken Keegler.

Second - If you need to talk it out, go somewhere safe. Your therapist, your business or life coach, or your best friend are people to consider. Your BNI "friends" are the absolute worst people to talk to because of the business relationship and professionalism you are working to maintain so that you have the trust to receive referrals.

Third - Put yourself in a Solutions Focused Mindset. Instead of wrapping yourself firmly around the disappointment, frustration, or even anger, move yourself towards emotions and actions that build your reputation up. Remember that there is a solution (and sometimes many solutions) to every problem, and it's not always your responsibility, skill, or ability to find that solution on your own.

In closing, when you have a negative experience with someone in BNI, the worst thing you can do is talk about that person behind their back. In order for us to maintain a positive and supportive environment in our referral communities, we must prioritize putting ourselves in the best position by finding

appropriate venues for our initial reactions, and then pursuing solutions-focused conversations that help us remedy the situation we're experiencing.


