Monthly Networking Tip: What I Gave Up When I Used an Excuse



Throughout my life I've struggled on and off with time management, over commitment, and juggling the realities of work, family, hobbies, and the impact of sudden shifts in my life (anyone thinking of Vermont's recent flooding?). All of these have resulted in my use of the good ol' excuse (a reason or explanation put forward to defend or justify a fault or offense).

Our culture has made it acceptable to have an excuse for everything. We've watched the adults in our lives use excuses since we were young and we're encouraged to use them throughout our adult lives.

Now I'm not talking about true justifications for why we may have dropped the ball. Justifications are reasons, facts, or circumstances that explains or defends why something went awry. However, when I reflect on my rationale for dropping the ball, the water can get muddy whether or not I'm using an excuse or a true justification. And regardless, each time I drop the ball, I cause harm to the quality and strength of the relationships I have with others (check out this amazing article by Rosann Kramer from September 2019's Givers Gain Newsletter). Consider this - every time I use an excuse, I hurt my referrability.

So today's networking tip is about first, bringing awareness to our use of excuses, and second, providing insight about how you might find a solution to this Relationship-Harming problem.

Truths

 \rightarrow You are a business owner, consultant, or employee

 \rightarrow You are busy (BNI's Founder, Dr. Ivan Misner prefers to say "My life is full" - please steal this from him \odot)

 \rightarrow Stuff comes up and you suddenly have to let someone down (yourself, a customer, a referral partner, a friend, etc)

Let's not ignore our humanity. We've been taught to keep busy - it's the American Way. But when our busyness causes harm to our lives, making things more complicated and maybe even drama-filled, it's worth taking the time to find solutions.

Solutions

 \rightarrow Avoid toxic people-pleasing (here's a fascinating article on this).

 \rightarrow Be a mile deep and an inch wide, not a mile wide and an inch short. In other words, find the areas of your life that you want to go deep into (examples: being a parent, honing out a nitch in your industry, rocking the Education Coordinator role, etc) and then find other people to take on the other parts of your life or business (refer to someone else in your contact sphere, hire virtual assistants, CPAs/CFOs-for-hire, HR companies, graphic designers, social media experts, house cleaners etc)

 \rightarrow Practice different ways of time management until you figure out the type that works for you. Here are some techniques you could try.

In summary, it's important to put yourself out there - to take on responsibilities and complete each task you set your mind to. It's also important to reflect on how you're balancing everything so that you rarely, if ever, drop the ball. When you do this, you'll enjoy life more and your relationships will flourish because of it! - Vickie Wacek, Executive Director, BNI Vermont


